2015 – 2016 Livestock Feeders Contract

Participating in the livestock feeding experience through the Agriscience Magnet Program (AMP) is a privilege, not a right. Students who fail to display a teachable attitude in the basics of successful livestock feeding forfeit the privilege of feeding a livestock project on the AMP Complex. Failure to comply with any of the basic elements of the following rules will be grounds for loss of privileges to participate in the livestock feeding experience.

1. Students and parents/guardians must be in compliance with the “AMP Complex Rules and Livestock Feeding Guidelines”.
2. Students must be a paid member of the James Madison FFA.
3. Feeding livestock for show is an educational opportunity that requires academic excellence. Any student deemed not academically eligible will not be permitted to compete (including UIL “Holiday Eligibility” periods).
4. Livestock must receive proper care and feeding for the duration of the feeding period. If a project supervisor determines the livestock project is not being fed properly, the livestock pen is not being kept sanitary, and/or the livestock project is being mistreated, then immediate removal of the livestock project will occur and the student will be dismissed from the livestock feeding experience.
5. A student or parent/guardian found feeding or administering medicine or other foreign substance that has not been approved by the project supervisor is subject to immediate removal of the livestock project and dismissal of the student from the livestock feeding experience.
6. Any physical and/or verbal altercation between student to student, parent to student, or parent to parent will result in the immediate removal of the livestock project and dismissal of the student(s) involved in the altercation from the livestock feeding experience.
7. Any student and/or parent/guardian found feeding or tampering with another student’s livestock project, unless given permission, will result in the immediate removal of the livestock project and dismissal of the student from the livestock feeding experience.
8. Any exercise equipment, fitting instrument, or livestock tool may only be brought onto the AMP Complex with the permission of the project supervisor.
9. Disciplinary action that results in a student being placed at Alternative High School will result in the immediate removal of the livestock project and dismissal of the student from the livestock feeding experience.
10. Unsatisfactory conduct by a student or any action deemed inappropriate by campus administration that occurs on campus or at a school-related activity may result in immediate removal of the livestock project and dismissal of the student from the livestock feeding experience.
